33rd Annual "Passing on the Traditions" Quilt Show

June 1, 3:00 pm – 7:00 pm, and June 2, 9:00 am – 4:00 pm

The 33rd annual Hands of Friendship Quilt Show will be located at the William Matthew Middle School, 1515 Cottage Grove Avenue, Kirksville, MO. You are invited to attend, and encouraged to enter one or more quilts into our show.

Our theme for 2018 is "Passing On the Traditions...to the Younger Generations", with this show being dedicated to Kimberlynn Bartlett, a Hands of Friendship Quilt Guild junior member who passed away in August 2017, and who is deeply missed.

You may enter your quilt through an electronic or paper form. Please visit the Hands of Friendship Quilt Guild webpage (<http://hofquiltguild.net/>) for the entry form. Please complete one entry form per quilt. While there is not an official limit to any individual's entries, we respectfully ask to please consider limiting your entries to no more than seven per person to allow space for a lot of different quilters to show their beautiful quilts. Due to space limitations, quilts will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis.

DEADLINE for entries is MAY 15, 2018. If you complete and submit a quilt show entry using this paper form, you do not have to submit anything online to enter your quilt.

The Hands of Friendship Quilt Guild cannot advertise quilts for sale. The Hands of Friendship Quilt Guild strives to protect every quilt in our care. All quilt show exhibitors are strongly encouraged to have their own insurance on each quilt that they enter into our show.

Quilt Drop Off and Pick-Up Procedures

Bring all entered quilts to the William Matthews Middle School on Friday, June 1, between 8:00 – 9:00 am. All possible care will be taken to safeguard your entries while they are in our possession. You will be given a receipt for each quilt at the time of delivery, and we will require your receipt when you pick up your entries on Saturday, June 2, from 4:30 – 5:00 pm. **The exhibit area will be inaccessible during the takedown process. No quilts will be released before 4:30 pm, and quilts must be picked up by 5:00 pm.**

If you are unable to bring or pick up your quilts during the designated times, please contact one of the quilt show committee members by May 28 to make arrangements.

Please plan to attend the quilt show and enjoy the quilts, vendors, demonstrations, and bed turnings! A recommended donation of \$5 is waived for all exhibitors and Hands of Friendship Quilt Guild Members.

We look forward to a tremendous show again this year!
